Sites for case studies chosen

Several SPs have chosen sites for case studies. SP2 (Future Imaginaries) and SP5 (Forest Landscapes) will be working with the Voxnadalen biosphere in Hälsingland. SP7 researchers (Marine and Coastal Landscapes) have picked Nämdö archipelago close to Stockholm as one of their case study sites and discussed collaboration with SP3 (Barriers and Opportunities for Change). SP3b has been exploring options for citizen deliberation in Nämdö and Voxnadalen. SP8 (Urban Landscapes) and SP2 have selected Årike Fyris in Uppsala for their analyses. SP9 (Mountain Landscapes) focuses on "the Greater Laponia" for data collection on historical and current land use.
